1 Montreal – Val-Jalbert – Zoo Sauvage - Chicoutimi

You will leave Montreal at 07:00am., it takes around 5 hours to drives to Val-Jalbert (\$21). You will suddenly be swept into the heart of the 1920's in the mono-industrial town, from the convent, the post- office, the gossips at the general store and the pulp mill. It will give you a glimpse at the daily lives of the working class families of the era who lived in the confusion when they learn their village was closing in 1927. From the breathtaking heights of the cable car, you will see all of the beauty of Chute Ouiatchouan. Then you will visit the Zoo Sauvage (\$30) de Saint-Felicien, where you will witness the intimate space of nearly 1000 animals in their natural environment. You'll also have to chance to take the "Sentiers de la nature" train for an unforgettable excursion; a memorable trip through the spectacular countryside, where large North American mammals live. You will stay in a hotel in Chicoutimi for the night. Hotel: 3 star hotel.

2 Chicoutimi – Fjord du Saguenay –Tadoussac

After breakfast, you will go to visit L'Anse-Saint-Jean, the most beautiful village in Quebec. Upon arrival, you will embark in a 2 hours Cruise (\$38) through the Fjord du Saguenay made of amid rocky outcroppings, capes, steep cliffs, pristine coves and tumbling falls. You will also experience the sudden apparition of Baie Trinite in as its splendor. As the boat moves slowly up this magnificent bay, the statue of Notre-Dame-du-Saguenay watches over you from its promontory. At noon you will have delicious French meal with the magnificent view of the lake. Afterwards you will visit the Pointe-Noire Interpretation & Observation Center (\$10) in Tadoussac. Overnight, you will stay in **Chateau Mont-Sainte-Anne** or a similar hotel.

3 Charlevoix (L'Isle-Aux-Coudres) – Grand Canyon - Montreal

After breakfast, you will take a ferry to L'Isle-aux-Coudres whose name Jacques Cartier is responsible for., and visit the Cidrerie, Verger Pedneault, economuseum of apple growers (\$2), Museum Les Voitures d'Eau (\$4) and Les Moulins de L'Isle-aux-Coudres (\$9). It will take around 2 hours to drive to the Grand Canyon (\$10). The highest cliff of a height of 180 feet, makes it possible to appreciate the vertiginous notch of the glacial era, which was duged by the force of the imposing St.-Anne fall (271 feet) in the rock of 900 million years of the Canadian Shield. Finally, you will leave for Montreal and arrive around 20:30pm.
